<b>R</b>	Children enquire through their experience of a concept or word, linking to the EYFS characteristics of learning, and include at least one golden thread concept/word. The curriculum includes at least two cycles of enquiry relating to a Christian context (Christmas and Easter) and two other units which focus on Judaism (Hanukah). Other religions may be covered depending on the cohort. Golden threads – <b>Community</b> and <b>Belonging</b> .

Type A, B and C concepts

- **Type A**
  - Concepts common to all people e.g. remembering, specialness and celebration.
- **Type B**
  - Concepts shared by many religions e.g. God, worship and symbolism.
- **Type C**
  - Concepts distinctive to particular religions e.g. the Trinity, the Hajj and resurrection.
