Rationale/Hook:

Lead Subject: PDL

Lead Subject: English

Lead Subject: Art

We will be sculpting using clay to create our face. We will be learning how to join clay and use different equipment to create shapes and texture.



Applied Subject: Computing

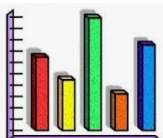
