# TITLE: All About Me!

YEAR: 2023 TERM: Autumn 1 YEAR GROUP: 4

**RATIONALE:** We are really excited for the beginning of the new year and getting to know each other better. We will be learning more about ourselves as well and about one another.

HOOK: Over the summer, we will all have collected 5 objects that we feel represent us. We will have a quiz to see if we can guess the owners.

## Lead subject: PDL

We will be exploring who we are as people and what makes us unique, as well as using this as a fantastic opportunity to really get to know one another. We will be guessing the mysterious owners of each box in an exciting quiz. We will also be revisiting the Park Gate Way and the Park Gate Values. We will be exploring these values through four exciting picture books: The Invisible Boy, Rosie Revere the Engineer, First Day Jitters and When I Grow Up.

# Lead subject: English

Alongside getting to know one another, we will be exploring ourselves and our own personalities. After looking at an expert model, we will write a character description of ourselves using rich vocabulary to create interesting noun phrases. These will then be displayed in the Year 3 and 4 shared areas so that we can all get to know one another even more!



## Lead subject: Art

We will be developing our sketching skills using the new medium of charcoal. We will investigate how to show light and shadow on a face using different ways of shading. Using this knowledge, we will create self-portraits to be displayed alongside the character descriptions.



## Applied subject: ICT and Computing

We will be furthering our knowledge regarding the SMART approach to digital literacy and internet safety skills.

#### Applied subject: Maths

We will be looking at presenting the data from people's guesses about who owns each shoe box. We will present this data in a table and a bar graph. In our maths lessons, we will be continuing to develop our understanding of 3-digit numbers and exploring the place value of 4-digit numbers allowing us to order and compare them.
