Rationale: As a year group, we will aim to convince Ms Newman that we can be trusted right from day 1 as we are the oldest year group in the school. We will create our own Tanka and Haiku poems to show our individuality and aspirations as we enter our Year 6 journey. Lead Subject: PDL

Lead Subject: English

Lead Subject: D.T
